- #2 Pencils Ticonderoga brand, 1 packages/boxes (please, no pencils with designs or patterns). #2 lead / wooden or mechanical If mechanical pencils are used, the students should also have their own personal supply of lead for the year.
- Extra erasers for pencils
- Colored Pencils 1, 12 count box
- Pens several black, blue, and red (Bic-type color ink)
- 2 Pocket Folders 5 glossy or plastic folders with holes to insert into binder.
- Composition Books 3 college ruled composition books
- Paper 1 ream of loose-leaf college ruled/lined notebook paper
- Highlighters 2 any color
- Science spiral or bound notebook, not a 3 ring binder; loose leaf paper for homework.
- Spanish writing utensils, a 3-ring binder and composition book for Spanish class. A Spanish-English dictionary is recommended but not required, since most dictionary resources are available online.
- Math (Mr. Duke) a compass, protractor, 12" ruler (English and metric labels), and scissors. Loose leaf, 3-ring notebook paper - non-college ruled. Three-ring binder(s).
