DRESS CODE PHILOSOPHY

Our policy is designed to provide plenty of options that permit creativity, in an environment designed for academic productivity, without excess distractions or compromising Biblical standards of modesty.

We ask that all parents/ guardians help us properly monitor their student's clothing. Our goal is that the dress code would not become an ongoing issue, so that positive academic, spiritual and social development would be our central focus. However, dress code accountability must be enforced, and we ask that parents/guardians and students understand our intent and intend to fully comply with these policies.

Students are expected to dress modestly and appropriately at school and all school sponsored events, whether they are held on or off school property. This includes but is not limited to: concerts, graduation, sporting events, banquets, fund raisers, class trips, etc. Students may be excluded from participation if attire is inappropriate.

IN GENERAL

- 1. Appearance should be neat and not sloppy, unkempt or immodest when attending school or any school event.
- 2. Layers of clothing are permitted, but all visible layers must meet guidelines at all times throughout the day.
- 3. Any clothing, dress, jewelry or hairstyle that draws excessive attention to self, distracts from learning or is determined to be inappropriate by the School Administration is unacceptable.
- 4. Students should always wear clothing that is loose fitting and fully covering. No undergarments should be visible, including darker or brighter undergarments showing through.
- 5. All clothing must be in good repair. Clothing with holes or cutouts is unacceptable.
- 6. Shoes- moccasins without solid soles or slipper type shoes are not acceptable for school and no open toed sandals, flip flops, clogs, or open backed shoes.
- 7. Hats, bandannas, kerchiefs or "do rags" are not permitted.
- 8. Pierced jewelry may only be worn in the ears of female students and this is true only in moderation. No other visible piercings. No gauges.

- 9. No visible tattoos or writing on your skin or clothing.
- 10. No chains on wallets, spike-like accessories, anything identifying with violence or darkness (like skulls, weapons), controversial pictures, incompatible logos (like Victoria's Secret "Pink"), political, or otherwise divisive material.
- 11. Avoid backpacks, notebooks and other accessories that contain above noted or similar controversial or inappropriate logos, pictures, symbols.
- 12. At times, the dress code will be different for students on field trips. Specific clothing guidelines will be given to the students several days prior to the trip. Modesty and a good testimony will always be stressed.

HAIR REQUIREMENTS

- Some hairstyles or hair colors may be extreme and deemed inappropriate for school.
- > Shaved designs in hair are not permitted.
- ➢ No Mohawk designs.
- Bangs may not cover your eyes.
- Hair colors must be a naturally occurring color and dyed hairstyles must be done in moderation or student will be asked to return his/her hair to its original color before being permitted to return to school.

Specifically for Boys:

- ▶ Hair may not touch the collar, or lay more than halfway down the ears.
- Cornrows that end in braids may not touch the collar.
- > Beards, mustaches and sideburns must be non-distracting and neatly groomed

Shirts (long/short sleeve)	Polo with collar or button-up shirt	Any solid color, striped, or plaid	Shirts may be worn untucked, must be hip length. All shirts must have a visible collar. No see-through or transparent fabric permitted. No cutouts.
Sweaters	Cardigan, v-neck, vest or crewneck	Any solid color	Shirt that follows dress code must be worn under all sweaters.
Sweatshirts	Crewneck, fleece or zip up Logo must not be larger than 2"X2". No additional wording.	Any solid color	Shirt that follows dress code must be worn under all sweatshirts. Non hooded sweatshirts/fleeces are permitted.
Pants	Pleated or plain, cotton twill or polyester, Cargo	Black, navy, khaki, white, gray, or brown	No bell-bottom, skinny legs, jogger pants or other trendy pants. Neatly hemmed. Must be worn at the natural waistline. No denim. Must be able to "pinch an inch"
